The conference will be held in the Emaus cloister in Prague, Czech republic and is organised by

the University of Prešov, (Orthodox theological faculty) Slovakia, the International Slavic University of G. R. Derzhavin, North Macedonia, and with the co-operation of

the Saint Petersburg Theological Academy, Russia, further the International NGO All Slavs Committee, and the Orthodox theological Institute in Prague.

The conference is taking place under the blessings of his Beatitude Rastislav, Metropolitan of the Orthodox Church in the Czech lands and Slovakia.
